## Italy and ecology in the spotlight at Luxexpo

(CS) This weekend Luxexpo in Kirchberg is buzzing with activity, and visitors can learn all about the latest news in green living, as well as getting a taster of food and design "Made in Italy".

On Friday afternoon, the 25th Oekofoire opened its doors. Some 200 stalls offer information on sustainable housing, low-emission mobility, organic cooking, as well as fair trade food, environmentally friendly clothes and more.

At the opening ceremony, president of the Mouvement Écologique (Méco) Blanche Weber said "we don't do green-washing here," but rather pointed out the growing interest of the Luxembourg population in sustainable and green living.

Environment Minister Marco Schank meanwhile praised the input of the Méco, and was happy to announce that a new building certificate was in the works. Unlike an energy pass, the new certificate will also take into account the sustainability of building materials used, as well as the connection to public transport networks.

On Saturday and Sunday the Foire will be open from 10am to 7pm with several highlights in store, such as Sustainability Minister Claude Wiseler and Luxembourg City Mayor Xavier Bettel taking to the show-cooking stage. For more information visit <u>oeko.lu</u>
